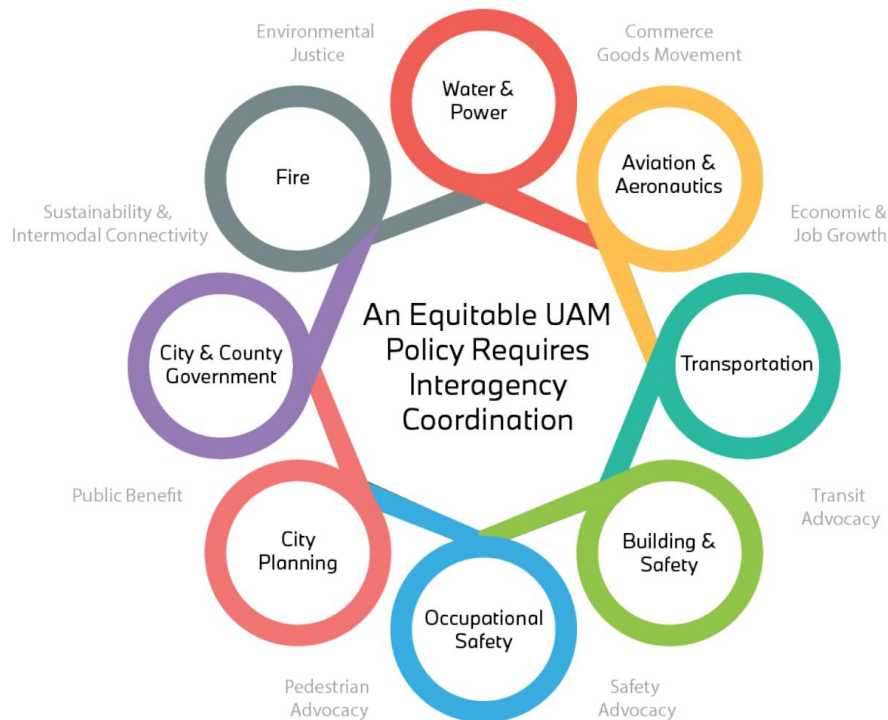
Land, Air, Transportation

- Uncharted convergence like 3D chess
 - Movement of goods and people
 - Technology is here and being used
 - City Planning can regulate where vertiports are located, connecting, and land use
 - Urban aviation infrastructure
- Land use policies address equity and sustainability
 - Opportunity to address new use in existing policies

Noise Pollution Map

- Unevenly distributed negative impacts from airport and heliport development and operations
- Interdisciplinary policy can mitigate veriport impacts
- *Example:* Limit time of day, flight path over sensitive biology, specify vehicle limits help mitigate negative effects to stakeholders
